In His creation of the new heavens and the new earth, Jesus demonstrates His victory over death, hell, sin, and Satan by...

I. Delivering creation from the visible, physical curse. (17-20)

A. Jesus creates, everlasting joy and gladness COME.

(17a, 18-19a)

B. The former things (weeping, sorrow, death) LEAVE.

(17b, 19b-20)

II. Delivering mankind from their spiritual exile. (21-24)

A. People inhabit the houses they build, and enjoy the fruit of the vineyards that they plant.

(21, 22a, 22c, 23a)

B. People given length of life as never previously known

(22b, 23b, also 20)

C. People given access to God as never previously known

(24)

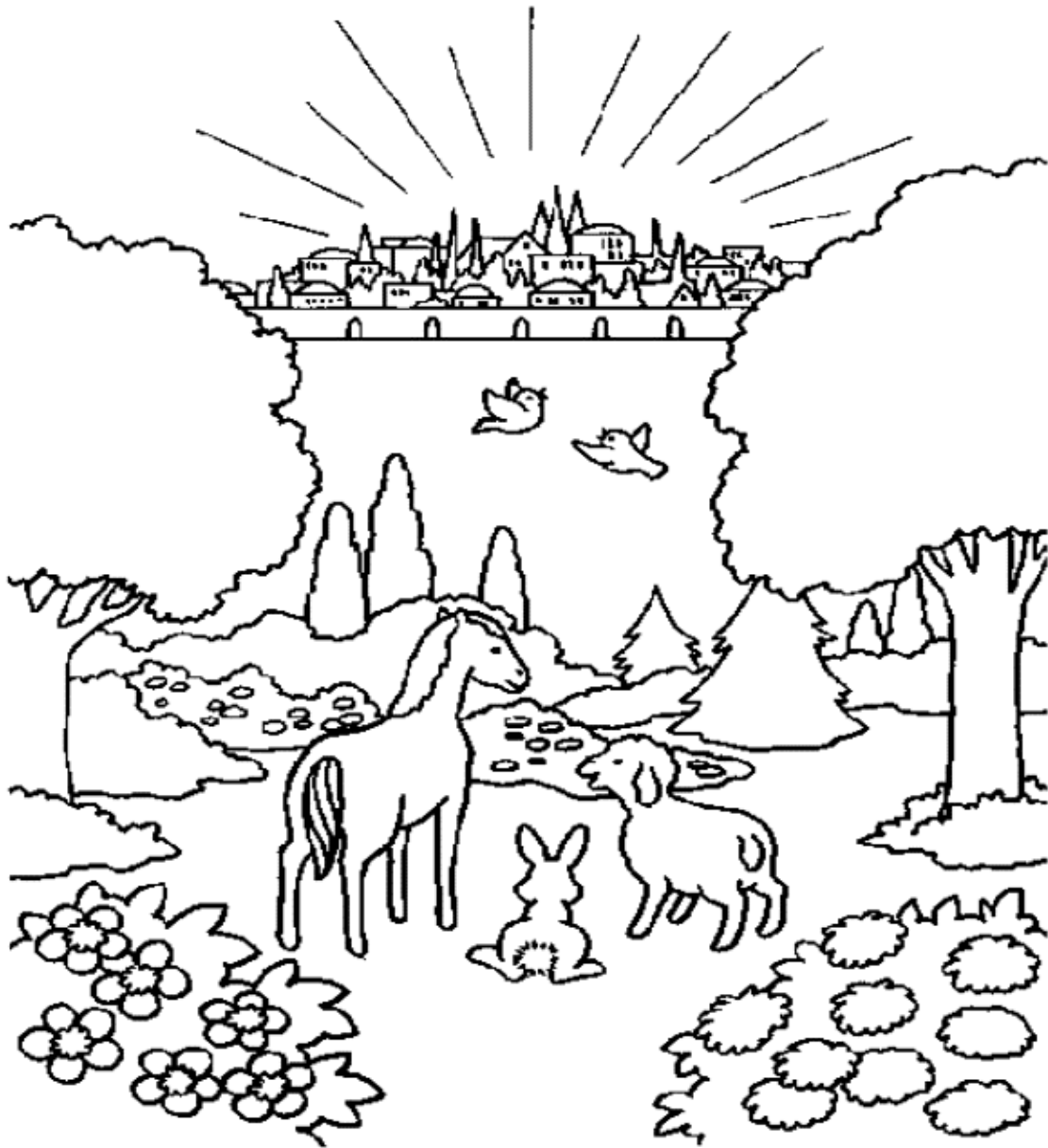
III. Defeating Satan and his rebellion fully and finally. (25)
